

Statement on California Proposition 65

Dear Customer:

The products that our company normally produces and sells comply with the standards of the California Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Substances Enforcement Act of 1986.

Bill No. 65, commonly known as California Bill No. 65 (Prop 65), is the "California Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Substances Enforcement Act", which was passed unanimously by California residents in November 1986

Its purpose is to protect California residents and the state's drinking water sources so that the water does not contain substances known to cause cancer, birth defects, or other reproductive development hazards, and to truthfully notify residents when such substances appear.

In the Act, there is no obvious risk level (NSRL) for the chemicals listed as carcinogenic and the maximum allowed.

The content of the bill's management: chemicals that cause cancer, teratogenesis, and reproductive toxicity.

The listed dose levels (MADL) of chemicals that can cause birth defects or other reproductive harm.

The products produced by our company will not come into contact with consumers' human skin during normal use, and will not cause major risks as stipulated in Proposal 65.

This declaration is intended to inform our customers that the products produced by our company do not exceed the exposure level of the safe harbor level.
